**Cost:** \$80 per person, which includes lodging for 2 nights and all meals from dinner on Friday through breakfast on Sunday.

**Payment:** The deadline for payment is September 15, 2019. Once you register, you will receive payment instruction in your Registration confirmation email

**Lodging:** Rooms and cabins are heated and sleep 2 to 6 people with bunk style beds with mattresses. Typically have 1 bathroom for every 4 people.

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## Driving Directions from Boise:

Access highway 55 North to McCall.

After almost 100 miles, you'll be nearing McCall.

Turn right onto Elo Road (just past the Mountain Life Church on the right as you are about to enter into McCall).

After 0.3 miles, Turn left onto S. Samson Trail

After 1.9 miles, Continue onto Spring Mt. Ranch Rd

After 1.3 miles, Turn right onto Lick Creek Rd/NF 48

Follow that for 0.9 miles. Turn left onto Forest Cove Rd.



After 300 feet, Turn right onto Shady Lane Loop.

After 0.2 miles, You will have arrived at your destination on the right.

**1075 Plymouth Rd**

**McCall ID 83638**

- Drive to McCall, ID
- Hwy 55 turns into N. 3<sup>rd</sup> St (whether you come from the north or the south!)
- From N. 3<sup>rd</sup> St, turn east (right, if driving north from Boise) onto Park Street - this curves into Thompson Avenue, just keep driving on it;
- Turn left on Davis Avenue;
- Turn right on Lick Creek Road;
- Turn left on Pilgrim Cove Road;
- Turn right on Miles Standish Road (a gravel road);
- Turn left onto Plymouth Road and follow the posted signs to Pilgrim Cove Camp!



## **Information about activities around McCall**

Saturday afternoon from 1pm to 5pm will be free time. There are many wonderful things to do right at Pilgrim Cove Camp:

- Hiking
- Play or relax on the beach or on the covered porch
- Canoeing/kayaking (life vests provided)
- New Rice Lodge has a small common area for crafting, playing games, etc.
- Creech Lodge dining hall is also available as a common area

The McCall area also has plenty of shopping, hiking, and biking opportunities. Area outfitters and guides also provide activities such as horseback riding, rafting, and boating on Payette Lake, although these activities will cost additional money.

- The city of McCall is a 10-minute drive from Pilgrim Cove Camp
- Ponderosa State Park is less than 2 miles away from the Camp
